Ingredients:

- 1 Scoop Mango Ice Cream
- 1 Ripe Banana
- Some Nuts
- Chocolate Syrup

METHOD:

Wear your chef cap and apron. Cut a banana in half lengthwise and lay it in the dish. Put the scoops of strawberry, vanilla and mango ice cream served in a row between the split bananas. Garnish it with crushed nuts and chocolate syrup. Enjoy your banana treat.
